Our mission is: to democratize access to culturally relevant, quality care for families while promoting economic mobility and professional growth for caregivers.

We have launched our alpha app in Atlanta and as we prepare to launch our beta, we are looking for a driven, mission-aligned, and experienced Senior Lead Engineer to join our dynamic founding team, and support us in further building out the product development team.

About the Position:

Village Nanny is seeking an entrepreneurial, mission-aligned Founding Sr. Lead Engineer with a strong technical background, solid leadership and people skills, and a proven track record in the mobile app development sector. The ideal candidate will lead the completion of our beta app development and oversee its successful launch to the App Store and Google Play Store, and will support the co-founders in sourcing and hiring additional Product team engineers. This position is the perfect position for a seasoned, entrepreneurial, self-directed engineer who is looking to play a meaningful role in the continued growth and success of an incredibly promising start-up.

Note: The final candidate selected for the role will begin on a contract basis at \$40-\$65/hour depending upon experience and credentials. Upon being offered a permanent position, candidate will become equity eligible after a 90-day wait period, and equity will be vested over a 4-year period.

Responsibilities

- Lead the development and optimization of the front-end and back-end of our mobile app, which is built on React Native and Firebase respectively.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to define, design, and ship new features, with immediate
 priorities being API integration with Stripe, Checkr, RevenueCat, and SendGrid, and feature building
 such as messaging/chat, push notifications, Uber-style ratings and reviews, and more.
- Be adaptable and responsive to early user feedback, and quickly iterate to solve for critical UX issues that arise.
- Ensure robustness, security, and application scalability, with an eye toward expansion from Atlanta to other
 L.S. cities
- Diagnose performance issues and fix bugs to enhance user experience.
- Recruit, Guide and mentor junior developers on the team.
- Prepare and maintain all applications utilizing standard development tools.
- Collaborate with executive leadership, UX and Instructional Design teams, and relevant sector partners to develop Village Nanny's Phase II Learning Management System, related content and user learning experiences
