Hey Coyote Families, we have a new movement opportunity for your children. Teachers have been given an activity called "Roll in the New Year." This activity involves rolling dice adding them up and performing the exercise that matches the number. Teachers will record every day their class participation on a

calendar. At the end of the month each class that participates will get a certificate to proudly display on the wall in their classroom. Don't forget that all our coyotes also have access to "Mr. Runk's Virtual Gym" where you can find brain break activities for recess or whenever they want to get active.



In lieu of our annual international festival event, this year we will celebrate being "Global Citizens" by participating in experiences each day, during the week of **January 25- January 29**, related to four continents: Africa, Asia, Europe, and South America. Teachers are responsible for planning activities that connect to grade level curriculum and the developmental ages of their students. In LAMP classes the Library, Art, Music, and PE teachers will also have activities that relate to these continents. Our SCA has also identified Friday, January 29th as a

KES spirit day for all of us to celebrate as a school community.

For all KES Coyote Families: Beginning January 25th, all KG-5 students will follow a new <u>instructional schedule</u> to accommodate students attending in person and also virtually. More details will be shared as we approach the start date with information for how our school's

parallel hybrid approach (teaching simultaneously virtual and in person students) will be implemented.

In person learning opportunities for all PreK-5 grade students will begin on Monday, January 25th. If you plan on your child returning, please read the following information:

- 1. Report to the front of KES on **Thursday**, **January 14 or Friday**, **January 15**, anytime between the hours of 2:00-6:00 PM to pick up an **ORANGE** folder with Return to School information and forms.
- 2. More information will be forthcoming regarding an orientation opportunity before students return.
- 3. School Hours for in person learning:
 - a. 7:40-8:00 Student arrival to KES (bus and car)
 - b. 8:00 tardy bell and school day begins
 - c. 1:00-1:15 student dismissal from KES (bus and car)
- **4.** If you selected a bus option, transportation information will be available on Tuesday, January 19. Unfortunately, no changes for selecting bus transportation will be made.
- 5. Review your student's contact information via the <u>HCPS PowerSchool Parent Portal</u>. In particular, it's important to ensure that emergency contact information is up-to-date.
