## Deferred or Waitlisted

\*Deferred--Being **deferred** can mean a wide variety of things. In most cases, the college has not completed its review of the applicant's file and is "deferring" their decision to a later date. Deferrals typically fall into two categories: Applicant applied under the Early Action or Early Decision plan and have been pushed back into the regular pool or the applicant applied under a regular decision or rolling admission and the college/university would like to have more information in order to make a decision about the application. In almost every case, a college or university would like to see more grades from the senior year or new test scores. If a school receives the information they want, they could admit the applicant earlier.

^Waitlisted--Being **waitlisted** is unlike being deferred; the college has finished reviewing the applicant's file and made a decision to put the applicant on a waiting list for admission.

- Being on a waitlist typically means that the applicant is placed within a "holding pattern" of sorts. The admissions committee may or may not admit students from the waitlist. And unlike a deferral situation, new information does not usually change a waitlist decision.
