Komike has been working on identifying the three tiers of funding in alignment with NLM.
(Thanks to Aunty Nalani for the work she has done to define the tiers)

Tier 1: Post High School Scholarships

Tier 2: Professional Development

Tier 3: Cultural Programs for Keiki though Kupuna

1. The applications online for Post High School scholarships will remain the same with the inclusion of trade schools.
2. Applications for the other tiers are almost finished with the support of Member Shannon Fowler.
3. Before the information is shared in our newsletter, we need to know how to keep each tiered application separate (to avoid being co-mingled with the scholarship applications).
4. Clarity regarding the scholarship budget for 2026 is needed to set parameters for the other tiers.

\$17,000 allocated for 2026

Scholarships dispersed for January 2026: \$6100. Balance of \$10,900.
