## **Brantley County Schools Charter School Petition Timeline**

\*As required by State Board Rule 160-4-9-.05, all Georgia Districts must establish a timeline for submitting and reviewing start-up charter school petitions. The timeline for the Brantley County School District is below.

- 1. Charter School shall submit a letter of intent to the school superintendent and School Board Chairman at least 6 months in advance of the charter petition being submitted.
- 2. Petitions for charter schools shall be submitted on or before October 1 of the year preceding the charter school's proposed opening.
- 3. The Brantley County School Board will review submitted charter petitions and approve or deny petitions by official vote by February 1 each year.
- 4. The Brantley County School Board will, by majority vote, approve or deny a petition no later than June 30th.
- 5. If the petition is denied, then within 20 days a detailed statement of denial will be provided to the petitioner, the SBOE and the OCSC, with the elements set forth in state statute.
- 6. If the petition is approved. There shall be a 6 month period between board approval of the charter petition and when the charter school opens and begins serving students. Upon approval, a copy must be submitted to OCSC and notice of approval will be sent to the petitioner within 30 days.
