Meet the Teacher Checklist (4th-8th Grades)

- ☐ Drop off your child's "teacher supplies" in the appropriate location.
 - 4th/5th = Drop supplies off in your child's Homeroom classroom.
 - 6th/7th/8th = Drop supplies off at the Middle School welcome table (bottom floor).
- ☐ Pick up your child's dismissal # for the afternoon carline.
 - 4th/5th = Pickup numbers can be obtained in your child's Homeroom classroom.
 - 6th/7th/8th = Pickup numbers can be obtained at the Middle School welcome table.
- ☐ Walk your child's schedule (in order of classes) and meet teachers.
 - You can obtain your child's schedule if you did not bring a copy from your child's Homeroom teacher (4th/5th) or the Middle School welcome table (6th/7th/8th).
- ☐ Visit the cafeteria to experience a taste of SAGE Dining
 - You can learn more about our daily lunch program and sample a few items too!

MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS ONLY (6th-8th Grades)

In addition to the items listed above, complete the additional tasks below.

- ☐ Pick up your child's locker assignment and weekly agenda from the gym.
 - LOCKER DIRECTIONS:
 - Turn the lock three times to the right to reset the lock
 - o Turn right until you reach the first number
 - o Turn left, pass the second number once, then stop on the second number
 - o Turn right until you reach the third number
 - Lift the latch
 - Be sure to check the locker combination and make sure your child is able to access their locker.
- ☐ <u>All</u> 6th graders and <u>New</u> 7th & 8th graders pick up your child's Chromebook device upstairs on the 7th & 8th hallway.
 - Returning 7th and 8th grade students may touch base with IT in the same location if you are having an issue with your Chromebook device.

REMINDERS FOR 1ST DAY OF CLASSES (TUESDAY, AUGUST 5)
