Materials Needed: Tin cans Hammer and nail Masking tape marker Tea light candles or LED candles

- 1. Tin Can: Start by thoroughly cleaning the tin can and removing any labels or sticky residue. Make sure it's completely dry before proceeding.
- 2. Design: You can create a design for your lantern or simply freehand it.
- 3. Secure the Design: If you're using a design template, attach it to the tin can using masking tape.
- 4. Mark the Design: Use a pencil or marker to trace the design onto the tin can. Apply enough pressure to leave an indentation on the can's surface, which will serve as your cutting guide.
- 5. CreateHoles: use a hammer and nail to make holes along the traced lines of design. These holes will allow the light from the candle to shine through.
- 8. Insert the Candle: Place a tea light candle or an LED candle inside the tin can.
- 9. Light the Lantern: Light the candle inside your tin can lantern, and enjoy the warm, flickering glow it produces.
