How did you find these dates?

Doing another listen-through of all the episodes, and reviewing scripts! A lot of episodes where days aren't mentioned have the date somewhere on the first page. Some episodes also have casual mentions to how much time passed ("a week ago", etc), so I even kept track of how many hours passed if they were included in the scripts, in case it went into the next day.

How do you know when day one is?

Two points of reference: Christmas day (580), and also [Gabriel Urbina says in the AMA](#) that August 15 2014 (the day the first episode was released) is also the day it occurs on. Then I used a [site](#) to help me calculate the dates corresponding with the days in the episodes.

Anything else?

Last updated: 26/12/2015 (after remaining season two scripts were released, save for the live show).

May 24 2013: *Day one*. Eiffel has no idea how to use any of his systems. Or pronounce Hephaestus.

May 4 2014: Minkowski's 36th birthday.

August 11 2014: Lovelace's 34th birthday.

August 15 2014: *Episode 1*. The first radio transmission is found. Hilbert's lab catches fire. Minkowski finds Eiffel's unopened copy of DSSPPM.

August 22 2014: *Episode 2*. Eiffel holds the last tube of toothpaste hostage.

August 23 2014: *Episode 2* (section three). Eiffel hallucinates at -40, and is forced out of stalemate when Hilbert melts the door to the comms room.

August 23 - September 2 2014: Eiffel is still serving his punishment in the brig. (If it's ten days like Hera said.)

September 18 2014: *Episode 3*. Biannual physical examination day. Specimen 34 appears.

September 19 ~ 24 2014: *Episode 4* takes place somewhere in this span of time? It spans two days. Eiffel gets caught in a storm, dislocates his shoulder, almost drowns in space. Resuscitated by Hilbert. (Possibly becomes undead.)

September 24 2014: Hilbert gives Eiffel Decima candy for the first time. (Still tastes like cinnamon.) AKA: Decima trials begin.

September 25 2014: *Episode 5*. Decima trials. Cigarette-flavour added to candy. Eiffel has a cough, morbilliform.

September 26 2014: Decima trials. Eiffel gets more cigarette candy. Morbilliform, cough, sore throat.

September 27 2014: Decima trials. Fever, headache, morbilliform, cough, sore throat, blurred vision. Eiffel faints and is moved to Hilbert's lab.

September ~30 2014: Decima trials. Eiffel unsure if it's been three days or not. Pulmonary infection added to list of symptoms.

September ~31 2014: Decima trial concludes. Eiffel considered healthy. Hidden log from Hilbert exposing this as a Decima trial.

October 6 2014: *Episode 6.* Hera knocked offline. Lovelace's aux power log is heard.

October 7 2014: A few hours after Hera is back online. Eiffel wondering about hearing "you're not the first".

October 18 2014: *Episode 7.* Hera and Minkowski's spat. Hilbert controlled by specimen 34.

October 20 2014: Passing through the gravitational field of a comet. Safeguarding sensitive equipment.

October 21 2014: Station chess tournament. Hilbert plays with handicaps. Generous ones.

October 22 2014: Orbital alignment allows them to see Earth, if they wish.

October 23 2014: Movie night with Home Alone 2.

October 24 2014: Mustard.

October 31 2014: *Episode 8.* Quarterly talent show. Box 953 is found. Fourier's journals are found. Minkowski fires a cannon and everything is immediately lost.

November 5 2014: *Episode 9.* The Empty Man cometh.

November 6 ~ December 24 2014: *Episode 10 and 11* occur at some point during this time.

(*Am I Alone, Now?* is harder to pinpoint because it could technically be whenever, but Hera does talk about Hilbert's code. Hilbert also references previous missions here. These both feel in preparation of the finale.) Koudelka's birthday sometime during this timeframe, unless it's closer to Christmas, since it takes two weeks to be received. (Minkowski says it's been about a year, but it's been a year and a half since mission start, and she refers to the talent show.) Time distortions and distortions of the station itself reported during this time.

December 25 2014: *Episode 12/13.* Hilbert tries to kill everyone. Hera's personality core forcibly extracted. Eiffel's 32nd birthday.

December 26 2014: *Episode 14.* Boxing day on Earth. Eiffel and Minkowski speak with Cutter. Lovelace's aux log is found and cleaned so they can listen to it.

December 28 2014: *Episode 15.* Minkowski and Eiffel interrogate Hilbert. He tells them about Decima. Eiffel demoted to experimental meatbag. Eiffel almost shot.

January 9 2015: First day of no-sleep for Eiffel and Minkowski.

January 10 2015: Second day of no-sleep.

January 11 2015: *Episode 16.* Everyone almost falls into the star. Hera restored. VX3 engine destroyed.

January 21 2015: *Episode 17.* Eiffel and Hera's bet about pop culture references. Pinpointed Gliese 163 in Dorado. Minkowski forgets DSSPPM 555.

January 31 2015: Hera's (third) birthday. If that's a thing AI celebrate.

February 2 2015: *Episode 18.* Hera accidentally almost kills Eiffel and Minkowski. Lovelace's other hidden logs are found. Selberg's identity revealed. *Episode 19*, later that day: Hera tries to kill Hilbert, and accidentally almost kills Eiffel.

February 8 2015: *Episode 20.* Minkowski pilots the Hephaestus during a solar storm. Specimen

34 steals a screwdriver. Day one of Minkowski's mission to catch the plant monster.

February 14 2015: *Episode 21.* Day six of Minkowski's mission to find Specimen 34. Minkowski gets knocked out by it. Eiffel pops her shoulder back in.

February 15 2015: Day seven with Minkowski. Eiffel and Hera have a pong rematch. Minkowski fires bullets through the mess hall ceiling.

February 17 2015: Day nine with Minkowski. Nets are set up as traps around the station. Eiffel gets caught in one that doesn't have acid set up yet.

February 18 2015: Day ten with Minkowski. Specimen 34 adapted to acid and is even bigger and more threatening. Hera and Eiffel attempt an intervention.

February 19 ~ 26 2015: Indeterminate date. Minkowski sets up motion sensors and eliminates two tentacles, five spikes, six leaf clusters.

February 27 2015: Day nineteen with Minkowski. She finds its lair, and the screwdriver. Eiffel gets caught in a trap and almost gets acid dumped on him. Minkowski and Specimen 34 come to an agreement.

February 28 2015: Lovelace's ship appears and docks. *Episode 22:* Hilbert confirms it's her. They find the bomb.

March 6 2015: Fourier's 32nd birthday. (If, y'know, she's still alive! *I have hope.*)

March 10 2015: *Episode 23.* Everyone gets (temporarily) locked out of the station while they attempt repairs on Lovelace's ship.

March 12 2015: *Episode 24.* Minkowski attempts tactical brain damage on Hera. They enlist Hilbert's help.

March 14 2015: *Episode 25.* Hilbert divulges some honest information about himself. Minkowski accidentally fixes Lovelace's ship. Eiffel coughs blood and passes out. *Episode 26.* Eiffel taken to Hilbert's lab and operated on. Lovelace gives blood.

March 21 2015: Eiffel declares himself done with bedrest. The star turns blue. *Episode 27.* Eiffel removes the motion reader on the hangar bay airlock. They get an incoming message from the centre of the star from the Dear Listeners. *Episode 28.* Lovelace gets an abdomen wound from shrapnel, also damaging arteries. Eiffel is jettisoned into space on Lovelace's barely functional ship.

July 15 2015: *Episode 29.* Minkowski sends pan-pan signal to Command.

September 30 2015: *Episode 30.* Eiffel is rescued by an unknown ship (later revealed to be the Urania)

October 5 2015: *Episode 31.* The crew of the Urania (Kepler, Jacobi, and Maxwell) + Eiffel arrive at the Hephaestus and take over operations.

November 30 2015: *Episode 33.* Kepler officially cancels Hilbert's work on the Decima project, though Hilbert later points out evidence that the regenerative properties may actually be working. Lovelace tries to break into Kepler's servers, but is caught by Jacobi and Maxwell.

December 24 2015: *Episode 34.* Eiffel intercepts the first music transmission since the conversation with the Dear Listeners. Kepler places the entire crew on high-alert for the subsequent 12 hours in two teams. Maxwell, Hera, Minkowski, Lovelace, and Hilbert on the Hephaestus: Funzo. Kepler, Jacobi, and Eiffel on the Urania: 20 questions, Jacobi tells Eiffel why he trusts Kepler, Kepler tells Eiffel he needs to change his perspective.

December 25 2015: *Episode 34.* Kepler calls off the vigil. Eiffel's 33rd birthday.

January 8 2016: *Episode 35.* Minkowski, Jacobi, and Maxwell express displeasure with the way Kepler has been treating them. Kepler responds by assigning the three of them plus Lovelace to sync data between the Hephaestus and his personal servers (Eiffel stays with him). While processing the data, the group realizes they have access to personal files on each other, such as Minkowski's rejection letter from Tisch's musical theatre program, personal logs, and psych evals. This alternately causes amusement, embarrassment, and tension in the room (depending on what information is revealed about who) and they eventually decide to leave all the files alone. One last file comes across the screen and Jacobi catches a glance and calls Minkowski over: Eiffel's court sentence, revealing he was convicted for one count of kidnapping and three counts of child endangerment.

January 9 2016: *Episode 35.* Minkowski does not bring up the court documents with Eiffel, but is clearly upset by them.

February 8 2016: *Episode 37.* Jacobi tries and fails to launch a probe (again). Hera picks up some signals from it before it's destroyed and as a result the station is buffeted by concussive blasts when she tries to use the audio system, forcing her to communicate in binary through Maxwell. Doug has the idea to divert the signal to another probe so they can analyze the unusual patterns underneath without destroying the station. The probe launch requires moving the Hephaestus dangerously close to being pulled into the star, but the crew successfully pulls off the launch.

February 10 2016: *Episode 37.* Hilbert announces that from the data they were able to gather, he has discovered a correlation to increased stellar activity and predicts a massive event in 3 months.

No dates mentioned: Episode 4 (takes place over the course of two consecutive days), 10 (Extreme Danger Bug), 11 (Am I Alone, Now?), Are Space Suits Itchy?, Variations on a theme, Episode 32 (Controlled Demolition), Episode 36 (Fire and Brimstone)
