

1 - Grant Program Guidelines and Process

Overview

Wake Up To Change awards grants (formerly known as the Adelaide White Ribbon Breakfast Grants) to support projects preventing violence against women and children in South Australia.

Grant Round

- One annual funding round
- Opens: Thursday 21 May 2026
- Closes: Friday 31 July 2026
- Announcement of successful grants: Tuesday 1 September 2026

In 2026, Wake Up To Change will award up to 5 grants of up to \$5,000 each. One larger grant of up to \$10,000 *may* also be awarded, depending on the strength and scale of applications received.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be based in South Australia
- Be a registered non-profit organisation or have an eligible auspice organisation
- Demonstrate a clear focus on preventing or responding to violence against women and children
- Have complied with all grant conditions, including reporting requirements, for any previous funding received from Wake Up To Change or the Adelaide White Ribbon Breakfast.

Application Process

Organisations must submit the completed and signed **2 - WUTC Grant Application Form** together with any attachments to: wakeuptochangesa@gmail.com

Assessment Criteria

Applications will be scored against:

1. Project Impact (40%)
 - Clear identification of need
 - Number of beneficiaries
 - Potential for long-term impact
2. Implementation Capability (30%)
 - Organisation track record
 - Realistic timeline and budget
 - Strong partnerships if relevant
3. Value for Money (30%)
 - Cost per beneficiary
 - Level of co-contribution (in-kind or financial)

Grant Management

Successful grantees must:

1. Acknowledge Wake Up To Change support in all project related materials
2. Complete and submit the **WUTC Final Report** within four weeks from project completion which includes:
 - Project outcomes and learnings
 - Financial acquittal
 - Beneficiary feedback
 - Photos/media
