Big Point: Humility

God's Word: A Warning Against Doing Wrong Things for the Wrong Reasons (Matthew 23:

1-11)

Memory Verse: Don't do anything only to get ahead. Don't do it because you are proud.

Instead, be humble. Value others more than yourselves. (Philippians 2:3)

Life Question: What are some things that you are tempted to be prideful about?

Intro

Welcome children and start by asking children if they remember what they learnt on Sunday. Quick recap by reading the Memory Verse together.

Activity & Discussion

<Instruction> Teachers show children pictures one by one. With each picture showed, teachers ask the following questions

- (1) What is happening here?
- (2) Who is the more "powerful" one?
- (3) What do you learn about humility?



- (1) Daddy is saying sorry to his son
- (2) Daddy is older, wiser, and knows better
- (3) Humility is knowing that you still make mistake and say sorry for your mistake



- (1) Daddy is playing soccer with his son
- (2) Daddy can play better. he knows more soccer tricks and more soccer rules. He can run faster too
- (3) Humility is teaching others what you know better because you want them to be as good or even better than you



- (1) A boy is giving his dog a shower
- (2) The boy is smarter than the dog, knows how to do more things
- (3) Humility is taking care of the weaker ones
