Main Functions of Board

- 1. Represent and address the needs and concerns of the volunteer corps.
- 2. Communication nexus within volunteer corps and between volunteer corps and staff.
- 3. To support staff with volunteer corps recruitment, orientation, professional development, training and mentorship opportunities.
- 4. To collaborate with staff on volunteer incentivization, retention, recognition and social events.
- Support the Museum and its mission, the Volunteer Program and the Volunteer Program staff.
- Assist the Volunteer Program staff with recruitment, recognition and retention, orientation, continuing education, communications, and social events.
- Support and represent all Museum volunteers.
- Serve as liaison between Museum staff and administration and the volunteers.
- Provide feedback to Museum staff and administration about programs, activities and experiences.
- Provide a forum for volunteers to voice concerns.
