


## Information and Rules

- Class to be held during the lunch break on FRIDAY , June 5, 2026
- Each YEDA team can have one entry
- Entry should be coach or coach representative, not open to current YEDA student riders
- Entry fee of \$25 to be paid prior to class - SIGN UP IN THE OFFICE
- All entry fee money is donated to YEDA SIF
- The class will be judged by Senior High winners of the YEDA Equine Knowledge Contest.
- The class will be a rail horsemanship class at the walk, jog, and lope
- **The coach can choose the horse they ride for the auction part of class**
- **Each rider will be able to show their skills while they are being auctioned**
- At the conclusion of the auction a draw for the horse you will ride in the class will take place. The horses in the draw will be the horses the coaches were riding for the auction part of the class. Please have a horse holder ready for the exchange of the horses.
- The total take of the auction proceeds will be distributed as follows: 50% donated to the YEDA SIF and the other 50% paid to the winning bidders of the first and second-place coaches.
- **The total of the winners' pot will be split 60% to the person who purchased the first-place coach and 40% to the person who purchased the second-place coach.**




