Judge A: Tim Abler

Tim Abler, of South Lyon, Michigan and Bradenton, Florida, judged his first horse show in 1971. He is currently licensed by nine breed associations. Tim has adjudicated nearly two thousand horse shows at local, state, national and international levels, across forty-seven states and sixteen foreign countries. In addition to judging, Tim serves on numerous horse related boards and committees and also donates his time as a clinician. His equine related honors include the Kevin Krueger Humanitarian Award, the Dodge-Miner Memorial Award and the Friend of 4-H Award. He has recently been inducted into the Pinto Horse Association's Judges Hall of Fame.



Judge B: Lynda Danielson

I have been judging for over 20 years and currently hold cards with AQHA, APHA, NSBA, ABRA, and IBHA. Throughout my career, I have had the opportunity to judge many prestigious events, including the All American Quarter Horse Congress, APHA World Show, NSBA World Show, ABRA World Show, and the NPHA Show in Sydney, Australia. I have also judged internationally in Canada, Tasmania, and Australia on multiple occasions. In addition to judging, I have trained Quarter Horses and clients to championships and top ten finishes at major shows and circuits. Today, I focus on raising Hunter Under Saddle prospects.



Judge C: Lori Gordon

Lori Gordon has managed Post Quarter Horses, a training and marketing business since 1986. She and her students have placed at both the Congress and AQHA World Show. She holds two bachelor of science degrees, 10 judges cards and is an AQHA/APHA Professional Horseman. She has judged World and Major Shows and given clinics domestically and abroad in 12 countries. Gordon was an AQHA Steward for five years and is a real estate investor.



Judge D: Kim Myers

Over the years that I have been judging, I have been honored to judge many major shows in the USA and also abroad. Including the NRHA Reining Futurity and the NRHA Derby and the NRBC and the Italian Reining Futurity numerous times. In regard to the All Around shows, I have judged the AQHA, AQHYA, APHA and NSBA World Championship Shows numerous times. I also been honored to judge the All American Quarter Horse Congress several times, the IEA Nationals and in regard to All Around Circuit Shows I have judged the Arizona Sun Circuit and many other Major Circuits across the USA. I have judged the Americana Show in Europe and been to Australia 3 times to judge their Australian Quarter Horse Summer Circuits.

- **The coach can choose the horse they ride for the auction part of class**
- **Each rider will be able to show their skills while they are being auctioned**
- At the conclusion of the auction a draw for the horse you will ride in the class will take place. The horses in the draw will be the horses the coaches were riding for the auction part of the class. Please have a horse holder ready for the exchange of the horses.
