Parler: to speak (Ashley Zhu)

Elle parle français= She speaks French

Chanter: to sing (camryn ronnow)

1. La chorale chante très bien. = the choir sings very well.

Gagner: To win (Joanna Wattimena)

2. Vous méritez de gagner. = You deserve to win.

Briller: To glitter (Srikar Susarla)

Aller - to go

Nous allons au restaurant (Fiona Liang)

Espère: To hope (Amanda Kelvin)

Je espère que vous faites du bien sur le test.

Aider: To help (Sulema Medina)

Son bien je voudre aider vous= It's ok I want to help you

Acheter = to buy (Sandra Garcia)

Je veux acheter un chemisier mais il est cher= I want to buy a blouse but it is expensive.

nager = to swim (mayely polanco)

voulez-vous aller nager? You want to go swimming?

Débrouiller = to manage, cope, or get by (Mia Lindsey)

jouer= to play (jugraj sidhu)

je jouer un basketball I play basketball

Penser= to think (Gavin Fredinburg)

Ma sœur aime penser. = my sister likes to think.

Elle aller un parti? = she went to a party
Aller= went (Janeth Hernandez)

La chorale chante très bien. = the choir sings very well.

Vous méritez de gagner. = You deserve to win.

Je preferer le rouge robe.= i prefer the red dress.(gabby Villarreal)
