Modules 1-8: Steps for Success

Module 1: What Is Dual Enrollment?

- Have your students describe in their own words what they think Dual Enrollment is after viewing the video.
- Locate the Dual Enrollment success camp page on the ECC website.

Module 2 First Step: Contact Your Counselor

• Have the students identify their ECC Dual Enrollment counselor and send them an email.

Module 3 Second Step: Access Your El Camino Email & MyECC Student Portal

- Login to MyECC account & trouble shoot if necessary.
- Login to Office ECC Email Office 360
- Login to Outlook, access your email
- List the things you can do through MyECC? Access your email, register for courses etc.
