E. ADDRESSING A SCORING ISSUE WITH WATER QUALITY C

I (Michael) would like to personally address a major scoring issue that occurred with Water Quality C. **I missed to run a quality check on this exam, which ended up being 40 pages**

long. Unfortunately, due to us being understaffed this year, we did not have the time to grade 40 tests which were each 40 pages long in time for the Awards Ceremony. **A decision was made to only grade the first 25 questions of the exam for all teams, and this was applied across the board (for all Water Quality C exams).**

A few teams' papers were graded to completion before this decision was made, which led to a major scoring issue in the preliminary results. **We have received scanned PDF copies for all affected tests, and the final results reflect the grade for only the first 25 questions for all teams that competed in this event.**

This was a last minute effort to ensure that we would be able to still run the Awards Ceremony on time and conclude the tournament. It was a very suboptimal solution, and the results are not 100% indicative of students' performance. **I would absolutely discourage any modifications to Team A/Team B or Varsity/JR Varsity rosters based on the Water Quality C results at our tournament.**

I sincerely apologize for this oversight on behalf of the team. We will make sure that all tests are thoroughly checked by a team member for future tournaments. We will also implement other quality control changes that make sure that all events are run better in the future.

As this tournament comes to an end, I would like to say THANK YOU to all of our participating teams for making history with us. Our initiative today is the product of hundreds of volunteers, students, parents, teachers, and coaches over the past four years.
