

2025 Camp Cedar Cliff/Biltmore Packing List

Camp Cedar Cliff is an outdoor education program. Please ensure clothing is appropriate for outdoor activities—expect to get dirty! Dress in layers to accommodate varying temperatures throughout the day. For warm weather, shorts and t-shirts are suitable, but always pack a sweater or jacket for cooler temperatures. In cold weather, layers are essential, including long pants and multiple warm shirts or jackets. Prepare for all weather conditions, including rain, and choose clothing that allows free movement for active participation.

Packing Tips:

- **Label** all items with your child's name.
- Students should be able to carry their own gear a short distance from the buses to the cabins, so please pack light.
- No additional money is needed for camp fees or food. However, students may bring a small amount (\$10-\$20 cash) for souvenirs if the group visits the camp store (t-shirts are \$12). **(STORE TBD - may not be open)**

Suggested Packing List for a 2-3 Day Program:

Clothing:

- 2-3 pairs of long pants and/or shorts
- 4 t-shirts
- 1-2 sweatshirts or fleece tops
- 1 jacket
- 3 sets of underwear
- 4 pairs of socks
- 2 pairs of shoes or boots (Closed-toe only; *No sandals or Crocs allowed*)
- Rain gear
- Pajamas
- Hat and gloves (for colder weather)
- Optional: thermal underwear for very cold weather

Linens:

- Twin bed sheet and blanket OR sleeping bag
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Towels and washcloths

Note: Cabins do not provide sheets, blankets, or pillows.

Toiletries:

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Brush or comb
- Soap and shampoo
- Optional: shower shoes
- Hand towel (*Paper towels are not supplied in cabins*)

Miscellaneous:

- Water bottle
 - Flashlight
 - Camera
 - Books, cards, or small games for free time
 - Cell phone (*For use only in cabins or for photos at Biltmore*)
 - Earbuds (*For the bus ride*)

Biltmore Estate Packing Guidelines

- **Closed-toe shoes** are required.
- **Uniform or UA spirit wear** is encouraged.
- Money for shopping or snacks (*recommendation: pre-paid gift cards instead of cash*).
- **Lunch is included in the trip price.**

Important Reminders:

- Chaperones and teachers **will not** hold student money or purchases.
- If a child loses money, it **cannot** be replaced by staff. Consider using pre-paid gift cards and take a photo of the front and back for deactivation if needed.
- **Bag Policy:** For Biltmore House entry, all bags, packages, and boxes will be inspected by security. Only **small personal bags** (no larger than **19" x 14" x 9"**) are permitted inside. Backpacks are not allowed on guided tours and must be left in a locker or vehicle.

Prohibited Items:

- Electronics (*Gaming systems will be confiscated*)
- Jewelry or expensive items
- Perfume or cologne
- Bluetooth speakers
- Candy, gum, or food (*unless required for dietary needs*)

All alternative snacks must be stored in the dining hall inside a labeled cooler, not in the cabins.
