Ballot Status: **On the Ballot**

Instructions

Fill in the oval for Jill Stein and Samson Kpadenou darkly and completely on your ballot. Do NOT write it in. **Note that New Jersey ballots may vary by county.**

Regardless of who is listed as the VP candidate running with Jill Stein, your vote will be counted for Jill Stein as President and Rudolph Ware as Vice President.

VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS



Identification is not required unless you are a first time voter who registered by mail and did not provide ID verification with application.

Dates and Deadlines

Absentee Ballot (No Excuse Required)

REQUEST FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT MUST BE RECEIVED BY October 29, 2024

(you must mail or return the application in person to your [County Clerk](#))

DEADLINE TO RETURN COMPLETED ABSENTEE BALLOT:

- **POSTMARKED BY 8:00 pm on November 5, 2024**
- **RECEIVED BY November 11, 2024** (if by mail)
- **8:00 pm on November 5, 2024** (if using a [secure ballot drop box](#))
- **5:00 pm on November 5, 2024** (if in person at your county's Board of Elections Office)

Those who requested an absentee ballot but want to vote in person: You may request an **Opt-Out Form** from your [county clerk](#). If your mail-in ballot has already been mailed for the election, you will not be able to vote on a machine at the polls.
