The **Ronne Award for Antarctic Research or Exploration** recognizes an early-to mid-career member or non-member (e.g., age 45 or less, 10-15 years in the field) with a demonstrated interest, ideally combined with actual experience in the Antarctic region. The nominee should have made contributions that have a significant and/or long-term impact related to the region.
