



POLICY RE SPEAKING ON BEHALF OF THE IGPNEA

(Reviewed Oct 23)

The Irish General Practice Nurses Educational Association (IGPNEA) is a professional membership body with Charitable Tax Exemption CHY 17932. The main object for which it is established is “the advancement of education in general practice in Ireland by promoting and assisting nurses in further education programmes and to provide a forum for the dissemination of information on developments in the general practice nursing field which will promote the highest standards of care to benefit the community”.

All activities aim to encourage and foster the highest standards within General Practice Nursing for the benefit of patients and their families. Every effort is made to ensure that the IGPNEA is promoted and that the good name of the IGPNEA is upheld and maintained. Any activities which are outside the association’s remit, or which may undermine its aims, shall not be undertaken.

IGPNEA members elect National Executive Committee Officers at each AGM. This includes a National PRO whose role includes making statements and/or speaking on behalf of the IGPNEA. Statements made by the National PRO or any of the NEC officers, on behalf of the association shall be pre-approved by all the NEC Officers, who will consult with the entire National Executive Committee whenever it is deemed necessary to do this.

No member may speak on behalf of the IGPNEA in any forum without the prior approval of the NEC Officers. Members who do so may have their membership terminated by the National Executive Committee, as per Article of Association No: 10.9.3
