

Studio Arts

This subject is split into 4 units:

Unit 1 - completed in year 10 or 11, you will learn about lots of different media types (like painting, photography, encaustics, etc) as a class. They explore artists to be inspired by and are introduced to writing up an "Exploration Proposal" and how to document a "media trial".

We will explore the history of art and write up a SAC comparing the work of two artists from different times and/or cultures. We will visit lots of gallery spaces.



Unit 2 - You will get to choose your favourite media type, ie photography, and focus your whole semester on it, with a new topic of your choosing as you write up a new Exploration Proposal - completing the entire process that a year 12 folio requires - a "Mini year 12" - submitting your folio and 1 artwork.

We will look at how artists create their individual style and also at the legal obligations of artists in a written SAC.

Unit 3 - In this unit, you will choose a topic to explore for the entire year. You will complete a folio of media trials based on your own Exploration Proposal and come up with Potential Directions which will formulate your art making in Unit 4.

We will explore the history of art and write up a SAC comparing the work of two artists from different times and/or cultures.

We will visit lots of gallery spaces to inform your SAC based on the art industry for unit 4.

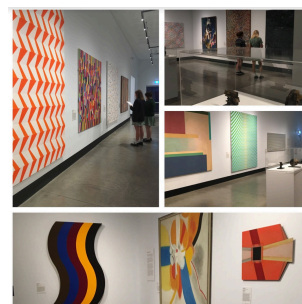
We will do end of year Exam prep.

Unit 4 - In this unit, you will focus on creating your 2 artworks and then reflecting on the Studio Process.

We will visit lots of gallery spaces to inform your SAC based on the art industry for unit 4. We will complete a SAC about the various gallery spaces that you have visited this year.

We will do end of year Exam prep together in class and attend an exam prep session.

You will sit an end of year examination.

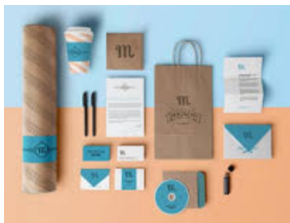
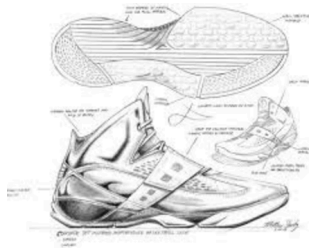
In VCD we will learn about
