### Log In

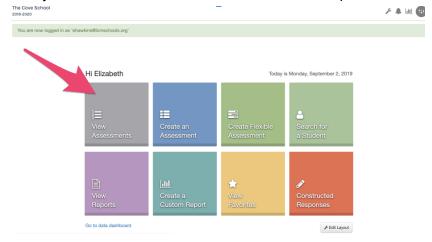
Go to <a href="https://lcmschools.illuminateed.com">https://lcmschools.illuminateed.com</a>. I recommend bookmarking this site.

At the login page choose Sign In with Google in the lower half of the screen.

You may be asked to identify which Google account you want to use. Select your lcmsd account. That's it. You're in.

#### The Grid

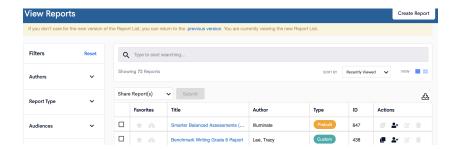
Now you will see the Illuminate Grid. Here is a sample of what Beth Hawkins sees:



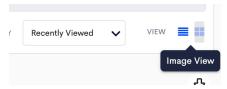
Today we are going to look at View Reports and Search for a Student. Let's start with View Reports.

# View Reports - CAASPP/SBAC

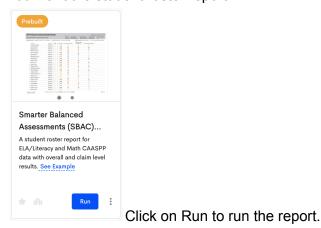
View Reports is the best way to see CAASPP/SBAC data for your whole class. After you click on View Reports you will see something like this:



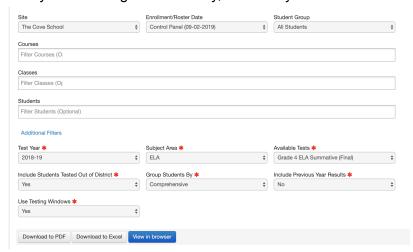
I prefer Image View over List View. To access that, click on the icons on the right of the screen:



Inside the search bar enter "SBAC" (not CAASPP). You want the student roster report.



Now your screen gets a bit crazy, because you have a bunch of options to choose from.

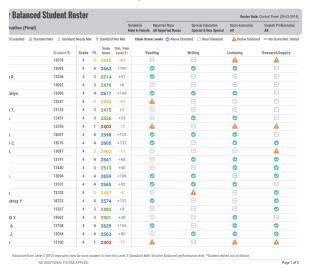


Middle school folks will want to filter classes because Illuminate includes students in all of your classes. I can help you figure out which classes are represented by the numbers. The easiest solution is a little trial and error - view the results for one class and see who is on the roster. Then you will know which classes are which.

Elementary folks can skip the top half of the options and just focus on the red asterisks.

Test Year is where you will identify if you want the results of your current students or last year's students. The default for Beth is to see the 2018-2019 fourth grade results, which would give her the scores for her current roster. Let's view it and see what we get.

View in Browser will let you see the report on the screen so then you can decide if you want to download it as a pdf. Here is what is generated (minus student names):



You can Download as PDF this report and then you will always have easy access to it.

This is the ELA report. You will need to run it again for Math. To do that, change the option in the Subject Area filter to Math. Click View in Browser again and you will see the math results.

### **Adding Previous Year Results**

Change the answer in the box for Include Previous Year Results to Yes.



View the Report in Browser again and you will see prior year proficiency levels, distance from Level 3 and scale score.



# View Reports - SRI Class Report

From the View Reports page, search for SRI. You will see a custom SRI report.

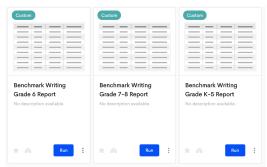


### Run it and you will see SRI results like this:



## View Reports - Benchmark Writing Class Report

From the View Reports page, search for "writing". Choose the grade level span that is accurate for your students. For Beth's class I chose the K-5 report.

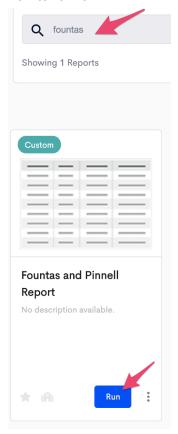


### When you run the report you will see something like this:

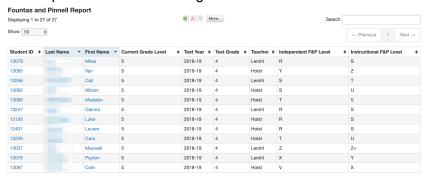

From the View Reports page, search for "fountas" and you will see a custom Fountas and Pinnell Report. Click Run to run it.

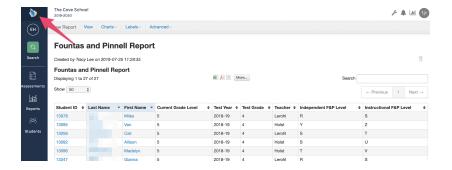


### Your report will look something like this:



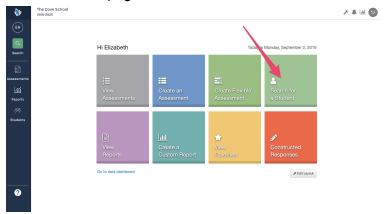
# Returning to Illuminate Home Page

You can always return to the Illuminate Grid by clicking on the Illuminate icon in the upper left of the screen.

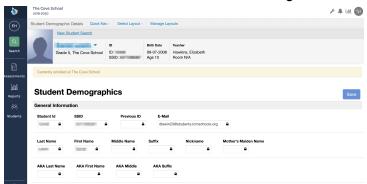


## Individual Student Lookup - State and Local Assessments

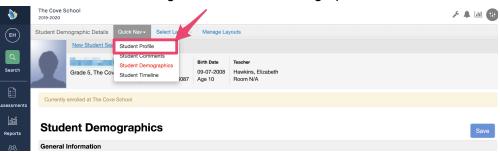
From the home page, select the Search for a Student button.



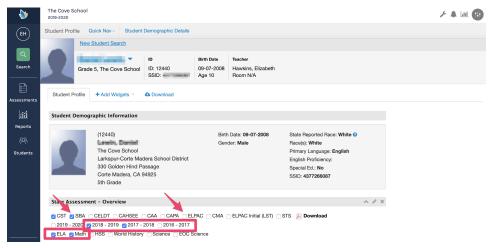
Enter a name to run a search. You will then get the default demographics page.



Go to Quick Nav and change from Student Demographics to Student Profile.



The check boxes will determine what data you can see.



You need to click the SBA box in order to see CAASPP/SBAC results. Choose the years you are interested in. Note that not all years will have data. Select ELA and/or Math, as needed.

Scroll down and you will be able to see CAASPP/SBAC scores, SRI, Benchmark Writing and F&P scores.
