End of Year Field Trip Dates/Criteria (Repeat Story Alert)

While it may seem like a long way off, I wanted to share the dates and criteria for this year's end-of-year field trips:

Note: Pricing for each trip will be based upon fundraising efforts made by each Grade-level team. This information will be shared in January of 2024, prior to ticket sales for each trip.

Criteria to attend:

- 1. May not have more than 10 absences prior to the date of reserving the ticket. If the total number of absences exceeds 10, only a doctor's note can excuse any dates from school.
- 2. Must have a Semester 1 cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- 3. May not have earned 4 or more referrals in FOCUS and/more than 3 days of OSS (prior to the school purchasing the tickets from the Theme Park).

4. Must have all obligations (fines/fees) paid in full (or on payment plan), prior to purchasing a ticket.
