Using any materials you like, create a poster or a 3-D model of the digestive system. It should include all of the organs/steps mentioned in your textbook. The poster/model should be labeled to explain what happens at each step, and the function of each organ.

- 6. Which diseases or disorders affect your organ? Give at least 3 examples.
- 7. Can a person live without your organ? Explain your answer.
