## **Ancient India Philosophies/Religions**


## **Introduction:**

Ancient India had many philosophies/religions, including Hinduism, Islam, Christianity, Buddhism, Jainism, and Sikhism. Philosophy/Religion was a very large part of everyday life; it influenced everything from art, clothes and activities to music, stories, and legends.

For this project, we will focus on Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam and Jainism. How did philosophy/religion influence ancient Indian life?

## The Task:

- 1. Identify elements of each religion and take notes on things such as: gods, clothing, symbols, important objects, main philosophy, rituals, texts...
- 2. Create a web (example to the right) that shows the influences and/or impacts of **EACH** (all 4, so 4 separate webs) of these religions on ancient Indian society.



<u>Booklet-</u> You and your partner will create a booklet including each philosophy/religion. Your booklet must include the following:

- An attractive COVER- includes title, names, period and date along with a picture to go along with your religions.
- Table of Contents- includes all pages in book properly numbered
- 4 webs(2 religions per page)- 1 for each religion- in this order- 1. Buddhism 2. Hinduism 3. Islam 4. Jainism
- 1 page of information about each religion with 2 pictures included per page to depict each religion. This can be done in bulleted main ideas(minimum of 10 important ideas). Give each religion a centered and underlined title- bulleted points underneath- pictures at the bottom.

## **The Process:**

- 1. Groups of 2 students.
- 2. Each person researches 2 Philosophy/Religions
- Buddhist Expert: Researches the customs of Buddhism
- Hinduist Expert: Researches the customs of Hinduism
- Jain Expert: Researches the customs of Jainism
- Islam Expert: Researches the customs of Islam
- 1. When doing research, consider these topics:
  - <u>Buddhist Expert:</u> What are some quotes from the Dalai Lama? What does the Buddha look like? What are some traditions in the Buddhist religion?
  - <u>Hinduist Expert:</u> What are some of the Hindu Gods and temples? Find information about prayer cloths. What is Herbal Sindoor?
  - Jain Expert: Find information on artifacts such as: prayer cords, bracelets, musical instruments, and pottery/offering bowls. What are some principles of the Jain Religion? Who are some Jain leaders?
  - Islam Expert: What are the basic tenets/beliefs of this religion? What are some
    of the religious practices or rituals? Who are their Gods/leaders? What texts or
    scriptures do they follow?
