



Evaluation FAQs

Where and when are my child's evaluations?

All evaluations are hosted at the Edmonton Soccer Dome. To view the evaluation schedule, click [HERE](#).

What do I do if my child is away for evaluations?

Please email your child's current coach and cc the appropriate program director.

Where do I go when I arrive for evaluations?

Please go to the check-in inside the Edmonton Soccer Dome. Volunteers will give your child(ren) a pinnie number and direct them to their field. For evaluations on Field 1 or Field 3 outdoors, a check-in table will be located outside.

When do families hear the results from evaluations?

All players will receive an email within seven days of the last evaluation session.

Upon receiving an offer, players will have 24 hours to accept a position on a team. If they do not accept within this time frame, the spot will be offered to another player.

Does my child need to attend both sessions, or can they pick one?

If possible, it is best to attend both evaluation sessions. If players can attend only one session, evaluators will assess them based on that session.

What should my child wear for evaluations?

Appropriate athletic clothing and, if possible, soccer cleats (as used outdoors) and shin pads.

What days will the training sessions and games be held?

Tentative game days from the Edmonton Minor Soccer Association (EMSA) are [HERE](#). These days are subject to change. The Club's training schedule is tentatively scheduled to

begin in the first two weeks of September. Training days and times cannot be determined until the Club's evaluations are complete and all teams are formed at the end of August.
