Outreach Project for August 2012: "GRACE Clothing Room Coordinator Dina Pesina is busy gearing up the GRACE Clothing Room for Back-to-School clothing needs. The Clothing Room urgently needs boys' and young men's clothing of all sizes, especially husky sizes for young boys. The stock of male clothing was depleted after May's Ridge Crest apartment fire. Young, active boys tend to wear out their clothing quickly, so families typically have fewer of these items available to donate at Donation Station. Other needed items include new socks and underwear of all sizes, as well as new or gently used shoes." John Nelson was given information on clothing needs and has printed this information on the web site. It is also listed
