SCOOBATHON CLUEDO

Hi everyone! Welcome to round 6 of Scoobathon!

For our last round back in May, we solved the mystery of The Black Knight, but we're switching it up for this round and playing a board game! This is very much based on Megwithbooks' TBR Cluedo because I've never actually played the game Cluedo before, only seen the movie lol, and every video I watched explaining the game just confused me more. So, this isn't exactly Cluedo the board game; it's more the vibes of Clue with a Scooby-Doo twist.

There are 9 rooms in total on our Scoobathon Cluedo board, and some of the squares have either a character from the Mystery Gang (Fred, Daphne, Velma, Shaggy or Scooby) or a different symbol (a pumpkin, the Mystery Machine, a burger, an original Scooby-Doo villain, Scooby Snacks, a magnifying glass, a ghost, a shoe or a book). Now, each room only has one symbol each (except for the Villains room, which only consists of different villains), but each symbol is a different colour, this way you can differentiate them and find out what your reading prompt is.

**I also want to give credit to Matt Needle for the art of the Scooby-Doo villains because I am not artistic in any way, but his artwork is amazing and was used for the Villains room on the board. You can find his artwork [here](#).*

Dates: October 01 - 31

How do I play?

- Roll a D6 to determine which character you start with
- Then roll a die to move your character and land on your reading prompt. If you roll and can't get yourself to a reading prompt, roll again.
- There's no mystery to solve this time around, and you can play however you like. You can make it your goal to go through every room or to hit as many or as few reading prompts as you like.
- You can go around the board as many times as you like. If you get through all of the rooms, you can either keep exploring and reading or start again as a new character.
- If the reading prompt says "read a book", you can, of course, read graphics (manga, graphic novels, comics, etc.), and you don't have to read the book physically.

Read a book under 200 pages.



Read a book at the top of your tbr (physically or anticipated)

ROOM TWO (FRED)



Read a translated book.



Read a book with a male main character.



Read a book with a found family dynamic.



Read a book with a vehicle on the cover.

ROOM THREE (SHAGGY)



Read a book that revolves around food



Read a book that you have high expectations for.



Read a backlist book.



Read a book in a different format from the last book you read.



Read a book only at night.



Read a book with a green cover.

ROOM FOUR



Read a book over 400 pages



Read a past/present Scoobathon book club read (if you've read them all, read another book by one of those authors).



Read a book with a weapon on the cover.



Read a book with an adaptation.



Read a book that's been on your tbr for over a year.



Read a book with a spooky setting.



Mood read.

ROOM FIVE (SCOOBY-DOO)



Read a book with food on the cover.



Eat a snack while you read.





Read a book with an animal on the cover.



Read the most recent book you hauled.



Read a book with a one-word title.

ROOM SIX



Read a book you've been avoiding.



Continue a series you started in 2025.



Read a book you've been meaning to read all year.



Read a new release.

ROOM SEVEN



Read a standalone.



Read a book with a title you love.

ROOM EIGHT (DAPHNE)



Read a book with a romance.



Read a book with a stunning cover.



Read a book written by a new to you author.



Read a retelling/reimagining.



Read a book with a female main character.

ROOM NINE (VELMA)



Read a library book (physical or Libby/Overdrive, etc.)



Read a book written by an author of colour.
