If you aren't familiar, **let me tell you all about them!** The pawpaw tree is a **unique, cold-hardy fruit tree** known for its **tropical-flavored fruit**. Ideal for **backyard orchards**, this low-maintenance tree grows well in a **variety of soils** and produces **large, greenish-yellow fruits with soft, creamy flesh**. It is perfect for adding a **rare and delicious** fruit to your garden! Typically reaching heights of **15-25 feet**, the pawpaw tree thrives in **partial to full sun** and requires **cross-pollination** for fruit production, so planting **more than one** is recommended.

Pawpaws are the **largest native edible fruit** in North America, often described as a **blend of banana, mango, and melon**. They have **three times** the amount of vitamin C as an apple and twice as much as a banana! Ripe pawpaws can be eaten fresh or used as a **substitute for bananas** in recipes, and they can be made into **ice cream, fruit drinks**, and even **beer!**
