Map: New ISSprOM, 1:4000 Scale for the event, 2.5 Contours

Terrain: One third rugged ocean bluffs, one third landscaped parkland, one third buildings and roads and

trails. Lots of fences.

Of Concern: Some of the military areas have fenced off sections you should not go in. Marked as uncrossable fencing. The rough open vegetation can sometimes be easy to cross and some areas are more grassy. Can be quite windy, hang on to your map. Near the start there can be many dogs, some off leash, even though they're supposed to be leashed.

Map Notes: Picnic areas are marked as paved circles with the fodder-rack symbol inside, looks like an up-arrow.

Parking is at <u>Joan Milke Flores Park</u>, 3601 S Gaffey St, San Pedro CA 90731 Our picnic reservation begins at 2:00pm and we plan to start running quarterfinal heats at 3:00pm.
