2nd/3rd Virtual Student Expectations

- -Students will use Google Classroom to access assignments and Google Meets.
- -Be on time and present to live Google Meet Sessions.
- -Dress appropriately for live instruction.
- -Have the camera on during live instruction. (Your teacher needs to be able to view you actively participating and making camera/eye contact.)
- -Mute microphone while teacher is giving instruction.
- -If you are unable to attend the live Google Meet Sessions, you must watch the recorded lessons.
- -Complete all assignments.
- -Keep in contact with the teacher. Ask the teacher for assignment clarification and/or help.

Student Expectations for Daily Independent Work

- ***In addition to the following assignments, students must complete any Google Classroom Assignments.***
- -Monday, Wednesday, & Friday: Students will work in iReady Math and Reading, for no less than 15 minutes on these days. At the end of the week this will be a total of 45 minutes for Reading iReady and 45 minutes for Math iReady.
- -<u>Tuesday & Thursday:</u> Students will login and read on Epic!. Students may only access Epic! during the school day.

Virtual Parent Expectations

- -Allow your child to complete his/her own work. It is important that the teacher knows your child's abilities. This ensures that instruction is based on the child.
- -Provide a clean and quiet work area for your child.
- -If you have any technical issues, Wifi and/or computer issues, let your child's teacher know immediately.
- -Stay in contact with your child's teacher, via email or Remind. Please be sure to provide a working phone number and email address.

How to Log into a FSD2 Chromebook and Google Classroom
