DBS Passages

It's up to you if you want to do a DBS with your guests. It really depends on what you sense and where your guests are at. If you decide to do a DBS, here's a few ideas. Feel free to choose your own!

<u>Here</u> are some example passages (not Easter themed).

READ & SUMMARIZE THE STORY

- **Have 2 people read** through the passage out loud. (Listening twice helps us pick up on things more than hearing it once).
- Ask 1 or 2 people to **summarize the story** in a few sentences.

DISCUSS

- 1. What **stands out** from this story?
- 2. What do we learn about **God**?
- 3. What do we learn about **people?**
- 4. What from this story can I **apply to my own life**, and who's someone I can **share** what I learned with?

PRAY

• **Pray** for each other. If you have a larger group, break into pairs or 3s to pray. Rather than taking a long time to share prayer requests, you can pray based on what was shared during the connection time, or do a listening style of prayer where you ask God to direct your prayers.
