

Privacy Policy for QuickPaste Keyboard

This Privacy Policy describes how **QuickPaste Keyboard** ("the App") handles your information. Your privacy is our priority, especially given the sensitive nature of keyboard input.

1. No Data Collection

QuickPaste Keyboard does not collect, store, or transmit any text you type. The App is designed to provide you with quick access to your pre-written snippets. We do not have access to your keystrokes, passwords, credit card numbers, or any other sensitive information typed while using the keyboard.

2. Full Access (iOS Settings)

To function correctly, iOS may ask you to "Allow Full Access" for the QuickPaste Keyboard.

- **Why we need it:** Full Access is used solely to allow the keyboard extension to communicate with the main app to load your saved snippets and to provide haptic feedback (if enabled).
- **Our Promise:** Even with Full Access enabled, the App **cannot** and **does not** send your data to any external servers or third parties.

3. Local Storage

All snippets, templates, and categories you create are stored **locally on your device**. We do not host your snippets on our servers, and we do not have a way to recover them if you delete the App or lose your device.

4. Third-Party Services

QuickPaste Keyboard does not use third-party analytics, advertising networks, or tracking SDKs. There is no background tracking of your location or usage habits.

5. Children's Privacy

Since we do not collect any personal information, the App is safe for users of all ages and complies with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA).
