In the 1930s, doctors in Puerto Rico falsely pushed women into sterilizations as the only means of contraception. It is estimated that between 1947-1948, 7% of Puerto Rican women in Puerto Rico were sterilized and by 1956, one out of three women suffered the same fate. In many cases, Puerto Ricans were told their tubes were being tied, but never told it was an irreversible procedure.
