Cutting Instructions

- Moody Mauve CS: 8-½"x 5-½" scored at 4-¼" so that your fold is on the top of your card base.
- Basic White CS: (2) 4-1/8" x 3-1/8"; scrap for sentiment and frond
- Lost Lagoon CS: small scrap for vase
- Copper Clay CS: small scrap for vase
- Earthen Elegance DSP: 5-¼"x 4";
 3-¾"x ½"; scrap for vase; scrap for flower.
- Fresh as a Daisy DSP: scrap for stems
- Natural Wavy Trim: 3-34" long

Assembly Instructions

1. Die cut one vase and handle from the scrap of Earthen Elegance DSP and

- glue the handle to the top back of the vase.
- 2. Stamp the tall vase using the Pecan Pie ink pad and die cut it out. Cut off about ½" off the top of the vase.
- Stamp the short vase with the Lost Lagoon ink pad onto the Lost Lagoon CS and die cut it out with the short vase die.
- 4. Die cut the flower from the scrap of Earthen Elegance DSP.
- Die cut two of the green stem pieces from the scrap of Fresh As a Daisy DSP.
- Using a blender brush spread Moody Mauve Ink onto a scrap of Basic White CS and then die cut the frond.
- 7. Die cut one 4-1/8" x 3-5/8" piece of Basic White CS with the 3rd from the largest Deckled Rectangle and emboss it with the Earthen Elegance die as shown in the video.
- 8. Die cut one 4-1/8" x 3-5%" piece of Basic White CS with the 2nd from the largest Decked Rectangle. Stamp the sentiment with Moody Mauve ink and the wheat with Pecan Pie Ink. Glue this piece to the inside of the card.
- 9. Glue the 5-1/4"x 4" piece of DSP to the front of your card.
- 10. Glue the Copper Clay vase to the left of the middle of the Basic White piece that is for the front of the card.
- 11. Glue the green stems to the left of the vase. Cut the stem of the flower

- and then glue it between the green stems.
- 12. Put two dimensionals on the back of the vase with the handles and place it to the left of the first vase so it looks like the flowers are coming out of it.
- 13. Glue the Natural Wavy Trim to the top half of the DSP that measures 3-¾"x ½" and the glue it across the lower half of the two vases and across the lower part of the Basic White card stock so it hangs over the right edge about ¼" or so.
- 14. Trim the stem on the Moody Mauve frond and cut the lowest fronds off.
 Then glue it to the right side of the Basic White piece.
- 15. Use two Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the Lost Lagoon vase, making sure the top one is high

- enough that it doesn't touch the trim, and place it over the frond.
- 16. Stamp a sentiment on Basic White CS using Moody Mauve ink and trim it down to the size you need. Attach it using mini Stampin' Dimensionals.

 Make sure you place it above the Natural Wavy Trim.
- 17. Put Stampin' Dimensionals on the back of the panel and center it on the front of the card.
- 18. Place three gold sequins randomly to finish off the front of the card.
- 19. Stamp the wheat in the lower left corner of the front of the envelope and the lower left corner of the flap.
