Principal's Pen

Our School Site Council is working on reviewing our Crisis Plans. These plans are part of the Safe School Plan. An abstract of the plan is always available for parents to review on our school website inside the Parent Handbook. The SSC also has a dedicated website on our school home page. Annually the SSC reviews and makes recommended changes to the Safe School Plan. The SSC also is responsible for our Plan for Student Achievement. Both plans eventually go before District Administration and then the BOE for review. I am grateful to our SSC for their serious dedication to making our school ever better for students and the community.

Our PTA is similarly busy with recruiting volunteers, fundraising, and managing special programs for students and the community. Volunteers are steadily taking the several steps to get on the "Approved Volunteer List". (Please the Volunteer link in the Resource Box below and the calendar above to get started. Volunteering is severely restricted post pandemic breakout.) Currently volunteerism is limited to safety/supervision (lunch duty and chaperoning) and art support. (Both of these tasks are high priorities in our Plan for Student Achievement.). Fundraising for the Arts, Instructional Assistants, and supplementary programs is going the best I have seen in my brief three years with MES. I am beyond grateful to our PTA Board. Special programs such the Family Picnic in August, the Beautification Day in September, and the SpookFest in October are examples of how PTA builds community ties.

Our teachers have not only been busy teaching students and communicating with parents but have also been assessing students' growth and needs. Quarterly each grade level sifts through the data, establishes targets, implementing best methods, and reports out to the entire faculty. Goals ranged from foundational literacy and fluency, to math automaticity, to social emotional skill development. These goals also support our Plan for Student Achievement.

Our parents and guardians deserve great praise. When I think of all the various traumas west Malibu and our greater community have endured and are enduring, I better appreciate our shared responsibility to raise and educate resilient students. Please do all you can to increase punctuality and appreciation for education. Our young students have a long school and career path before them and a good start is key. Our students are so well-behaved and committed to doing their best. This is not an accident but rather a testament to our parents and guardians.

Last week we <u>again</u> had no positive Covid tests. We remain steadfast in protecting our school community and are so relieved when we get good reports. Please see the Parent Resource box below for more details on how we are taking extra steps to keep the pandemic from closing down our school and to keep everyone healthy. Please check your email daily, including each night and each morning before coming to school, to see if a positive COVID-19 case has been identified in your child's class and if your child needs to follow the quarantine protocols. Sometimes we are informed of a positive case late at night, and we need to inform multiple families as quickly as possible that their child needs to be quarantined. If a positive case is identified in your child's class, please know that district nursing staff will follow up with you as part of contact tracing. If you have specific questions please email me directly. I am glad to help.

DreamBox - Family Dashboard

DreamBox is a signature program for MES. DreamBox is adaptive and builds conceptual understanding through games. Students are expected to complete five (5) lessons a week. Dreambox is accessible through Clever on our school website: Link. Students who do so will be recognized regularly at MES. DreamBox also provides data to teachers who can in turn customize assignments for students. Our Teacher Leadership Team and the SSC continue to prioritize DreamBox. DreamBox not only
