- 4. What do you think is the purpose of Enobarbus's description of Cleopatra?
- 5. What does the soothsayer tell Antony? What is Antony's reaction to his statements?
- 6. How does Cleopatra react to the news of Antony's marriage? Does her reaction surprise you?
- 7. Why was Pompey so ready to challenge the authority of the Second Triumvirate? How do the parties resolve the conflict?
- 8. What does Enobarbus predict for Antony as a result of recent marriage?
- 9. What do you think about the character of Enobarbus? What role does he play in Antony's life? In the play?
- 10. What is Pompey's reaction to Menas's suggestion? Why does he react this way? How does Menas react to Pompey's decision?
