Outcome: This event fostered teamwork and critical thinking skills among participants, encouraging them to apply their technical knowledge in creative ways.



Outcome: Participants demonstrated improved comprehension of digital logic concepts and their real-world applications.



- Aptitude tests to sharpen analytical thinking


Outcome: Students gained valuable experience in interview techniques and professional communication, better preparing them for future career opportunities.
