Student Expectations for Internet Etiquette (Netiquette)

Students are expected to use proper web course Netiquette (a word that is a combination of *Internet* and *etiquette*). This means that students will be courteous and use common sense while posting or emailing assignments or projects.

1. Be polite. Never send, or encourage others to send, abusive messages.
2. Use appropriate language. Remember that you are a representative of our school and of Jesus Christ. You may be alone with your computer, but what you say and do can be viewed globally! Never swear; use vulgarities, or any other inappropriate language. Illegal activities of any kind are strictly forbidden.
3. Maintain your privacy. Do not reveal your home address, personal phone number, or addresses or phone numbers of other students.
4. Electronic mail (e-mail) is not guaranteed to be private. Messages related to or in support of illegal activities must be reported to the authorities. Do not read, copy, forward, or print other people's mail without their permission.
5. You are responsible for posting, attaching, and/or submitting your own work. Plagiarism will not be tolerated and may result in a failing grade.
6. Avoid typing in all caps. Typing in caps means that you are screaming or shouting.
7. Treat discussions and other online postings as a serious communication tool. Post data that is relevant to the item up for discussion and follow an academic style of writing.
