Principal's Report (SF)	 School Improvement Plan- We have met with teachers to come up with new SIP. Math scores have been improving, and now we are focused on language. The main goals are supporting student voice 	

	 (with equity in mind), how to utilize that student voice, and indigenous education. School Budget- is quite small. Until last year, we were able to carry over from previous years. We cannot carry over more than 12 percent. The school is now in charge of covering costs not previously required to. VG- is model school funding incorporated in this? KS-no, but we find out in December how much we will be funded through model school program. We use that funding for field trips and events.
Chair Report (KR, CR)	 Community Support Worker (CSW): We still do not have one assigned yet. Ricardo, a member of the community, has volunteered to step in when needed. Library Representative, TPL – we also do not have a rep from Weston Library tonight. They plan to attend every other meeting Curriculum Night: The BBQ was a great success. Staff was very happy with the turnout. School Statement of Needs (SSON); This has been submitted! CR- we reached out to school community, but did not receive any feedback. KR- I think in this case, no news is good news Innovation Grant: The application was supposed to be submitted yesterday, but the deadline has been extended. MR is going to submit the application. CR- this year's topic is mental health. There are three sessions. First is "Screenager," which relates to teens and screen usage. Second

is by an organization called Boost, which has a variety of topics to select from. And the third could be one focusing on trauma. VG- where did trauma come from? KR- the idea was to diversify topics.
