## **Order of Operations**

**MEASURE**

**SUBTRACT**

**DIVIDE**

**DRAW**

	Step 1: Draw two rectangles. One representing your photograph (generally smaller) and one representing your drawing/painting surface (generally larger).
	Step 2: Measure the height and width of your photograph and drawing/painting surface. Write the measurements down next to each of the rectangles.
	Step 3: Subtract the height of the PHOTO from the height of the drawing paper/surface and subtract the width of the photo from the width of the drawing paper/surface.
	Step 4: Divide the “extra” height leftovers by two for an even border. Divide the “extra” width leftovers by two for an even border.
	Step 5: Draw your border and then grid the inside (LIGHTLY) into 1x1 inch sections.
