Attendance in “Live” eLearning Instruction

Attendance during “Live” eLearning is logged daily based on student attendance in the school’s structured schedule and meaningful participation in “live” eLearning Google Meet sessions. Students/guardians can refer to the LPCSC eLearning page for any technology issues during the live eLearning sessions. If a student is unsuccessful with troubleshooting attempts to participate in the live session, the teacher or school office should be contacted as soon as possible.

Students should follow their teacher’s guidance about participation expectations during live eLearning. The following points generally address what it means to participate in live eLearning to earn credit for attendance meaningfully:

- The camera is left on during live eLearning Google Meet sessions
- The student is visible on screen at all times unless permitted by the teacher
- The student stays muted unless permitted by the teacher
- The student demonstrates respectful behavior and follows live eLearning Google Meet rules established by the school/teacher

Attendance for “Posted” eLearning Days

If a student does not participate in the eLearning day (turn in work by the assigned deadline), they will be marked with an "unexcused absence" unless a valid excuse is given to the school for the missed eLearning day.

Assignments

Assignments for eLearning schoolwork must be submitted by 5:00 PM the day after the eLearning day, unless otherwise directed by the teacher.

Students who have difficulties with their assignments or who have issues that prevent them from completing their work must communicate with their teacher as soon as possible so that the teacher can set an appropriate modified due date at their discretion.

Information about Inclement Weather Days

Both built-in snow makeup days (February 13 and February 16) have now been used. Moving forward, we will utilize eLearning options to avoid extending the school calendar too close to graduation.

eLearning Days - Revised Plan for Remainder of School Year

For any additional weather-related school cancellations this year, we will use eLearning days in the following order:

First: Three "Posted Lessons" Days (Asynchronous eLearning)

We can use up to three days where teachers post assignments online for students to complete independently. Teachers will be available during office hours if students need help. This is similar to what we've used in past years for eLearning days. **LPCSC has three Posted Lesson days remaining for the 2025-26 school year.**

After that: "Live eLearning" Days (Synchronous)

Once we've used our three Posted Lessons days, any additional weather cancellations will be Live eLearning days. These require at least 50% face-to-face instruction via Google Meet, with teachers delivering instruction in real time. This format allows these days to count toward our required 180 school days.

Please Note: While we plan to use our Posted Lessons days first, there may be situations, such as an extended closure due to a severe storm, in which we may incorporate a Live eLearning day earlier in the sequence. This flexibility allows us to better support student learning during prolonged closures and preserve Posted Lessons days for future use. We will communicate clearly whenever this approach is needed.
