**Directions:** As a group, complete the rubric together for your project.

1. For each of the larger categories, **highlight** each sub-category of the rubric.

2. Determine the corresponding number grade for each category and write the number in the “Score” area to the right of each rubric category.

★ Scores with a .25, .5, or .75 are ok, for example 3.75 (just make sure the highlighting matches)

★ Note that you will have to add each sub-category grade together and divide by the total number in that category to come up with the average for each category.

3. You will have three separate grading categories for this assignment. (Content, Format and Layout, and Spelling and Proofreading) Here’s how you put it all together for a final average. First, multiple the content grade by 2, then add the Format and Layout Grade, and then multiply the Spelling and Proofreading Grade by 2. This will give you a Final Grade Number. You then divide the final grade number by the maximum points possible, 40. (See chart below)
