

General Rules and Consequences

AVID Student: _____

The following rules are either in concurrence with Poway Unified School District rules and procedures or are unique to an extended field trip but still within the guidelines of the District. These rules and consequences are not the only rules that apply on the trip but are ones that need to be addressed and emphasized.

We expect the student/participant to obey the following rules of behavior:

1. The student is to follow the directions and the rules and regulations established by the chaperones both prior and during the tour.
2. The student shall not be involved in any way with smoking, alcohol, illegal drugs, vandalism, theft, or any other type of behavior that is judged by the chaperones to detrimental to health, well-being, safety, or reputation of him/herself or anyone else in the group including the chaperones. There will be no violation of California Education Code 48900a-48900q including, but not limited to, Alcohol and/or controlled substance use and/or abuse.
3. Curfew will be at 10:00 p.m. every night, unless otherwise stated by the chaperones.
4. There will be no excessive noise between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am in the hotel.
5. There will be no leaving your room after curfew.
6. The student shall comply with all the rules and regulations of the various governmental and commercial agencies (such as airlines, hotels, bus companies, etc.).
7. The student shall remain with the group.
8. The student shall respect and follow the directions of the tour guide, chaperones, and hotel supervisors.
9. No throwing of any object or tampering with any property is allowed.
10. The use of any facilities carries with it the responsibility of leaving them in the same condition in which they were found. The student is responsible for the damage.
11. The student may never leave the hotel unless accompanied by a chaperone.
12. The student must sleep in his/her assigned room each night.
13. Good common sense, respect, and consideration for others and their property should be practiced daily.
14. Cell Phone Policy: Use of a personal cell phone's not permitted during narrated portions of the tour.

If the student should violate any of these rules, he/she may be sent home at the discretion of the chaperones. In such cases the parent/guardian will be contacted and the student sent home at the parent's expense. Results include but are not limited to the student being sent home at parent's expense via public transportation, removal from the AVID program, campus clean up, detention, suspension, and/or expulsion.
