Announcing Auditions for our Fall Play

PVMS is pleased to announce our fall play, *Heist at the Giardina Museum*. This original play is based on an unsolved theft of artwork that occurred in 1990. Five teens take on the task of trying to solve the mystery. There are 14 characters and most roles will be double cast. When an actor is not on for their main role, they will be part of the ensemble or will be members of the stage crew for that performance.

Rehearsals will take place after school Monday - Thursdays with leads needing to attend more rehearsals than characters in fewer scenes. Performances will be November 13 - 15 at 7 pm, and November 15 at 1 pm.

Being a part of a production is a commitment of time and energy. Students who are interested in theatre but cannot commit to regular rehearsals might consider requesting to be on a crew (lightboard operator, sound crew, props crew, or paint crew) which require a commitment of fewer days. A rehearsal schedule will be posted on Canvas in Student Resources, in the PVMS Theatre News module.

Auditions will take place September 3 and 4. Actors should only attend one of the auditions. Permission slips and audition information for actors and crew can be picked up from Ms. Clark in Portable 2 or from folders outside the music lab (last year's theatre classroom). Students will need to have a signed permission slip to stay after school and to be a part of the play.
