Art	• Learning Targets for this week: ○ I can draw an enlargement of an object with accurate proportion. (The shape of the object matches the original image and the size will be double.) ○ I can represent dark, medium, and light gray values by shading an object to match an original image. ○ I can present quality work by erasing my grid lines, making controlled pencils marks when shading, cleaning up fingerprints and smudges, and keeping my paper flat and free of tears or creases. ○ I can draw a scene from my environment that demonstrates careful observation of textures and values. In class, students are drawing an image in proportion by doubling its size. They will use the drawing pencils provided in their drawing kits to shade the image with dark, medium and light gray values. These will be completed at home during their online days. Their online assignments will give directions for work they will complete using the drawing materials provided in class.
