

What's Under the Pavilion

The Pavilion is being split into two sections to make it easier for competitors to find what they're looking for and to allow the Show Jumping judge and the Scorers a somewhat quieter work environment. Competitors and spectators will be limited to the west side (the side with the bleachers and tables) and the Officials and Volunteers will be on the east side.

The '**Competitor's Corner**' will have the following:

- Scores, dressage tests and awards all in one place. Dressage tests will be in folders baskets indicating the level next to the scores.
- Awards will be available after the $\frac{1}{2}$ hour inquire time is over and will be hanging to the LEFT of the scoresheets.
- Maps – both Cross Country and Show Jumping
- Order of Go
- Notice board for any last-minute announcements
- Lost and found basket.
- Inquiry forms. If you are questioning a scoring issue, fill out the form and give it to scoring. You will be notified of the result of the inquiry. Remember, if you are looking at scores online and it says 'provisional' they are still being worked on and are not final until posted.

Volunteers

- Volunteer schedule and jump judge assignments will be posted.
- Pick up their materials, water, and snacks.
- Lunch order forms will be available. Be sure to fill out the correct form for the phase you will be at lunchtime and turn it in before heading to your post.
- Jump Judges, after you have gotten your material and snacks, please move to the other side of the pavilion for the briefing as Show Jumping will be in progress and we don't want to disturb them.
