What is a Parent-School Learning Contract?

It is an agreement that outlines how parents, the school staff and students share the responsibility for student achievement and school climate.

The contract:

- 1. Defines the learning responsibilities of parents, school staff and students. The contract provides guidelines for everyone involved in each student's success.
- 2. Is as strong as the people who believe in it and use it.
- 3. Will help us all to offer a consistent and high quality environment for our students, parents and staff.

Parent/Caregiver Responsibilities

I will strive to...

- Communicate respectfully with school staff and administration.
- Support the GSHS cell phone policy: teachers will put phones out of reach during class.
- Make my best effort to ensure that my child comes to school well rested, fed and will communicate with the school if I need assistance.
- Have my child attend school every day and be on time.
- Provide an appropriate environment and set a routine for studying and homework.
- Provide for my child's physical and emotional needs, e.g. glasses, hearing aids, stability, support, etc. and communicate with the school if I need assistance.
- Monitor my student's grades and attendance through Infinite Campus (App strongly suggested)
- Check Schoology once a week with my child regarding assignments and homework.
- Participate in Parent/Teacher/Student conferences and/or communicate directly with teachers.

Student responsibilities

I will strive to...

- Believe that I can and will learn.
- Be on time and in class daily.
- Have my materials ready for class and give my best effort.
- Complete homework.
- Maintain an organizational system to manage assignments and tests.
- Self advocate by communicating questions and/or problems to my teachers, counselors, and/or school administrators.
- Be respectful of all students, teachers, school staff and property (on and off campus).
- Make effective use of Tutorial and use student tutors.
- Be brave and ask questions if I don't understand what I am reading or what the directions are.
- Take responsibility for the consequences for both unexcused and excused absences.
- Respectfully follow the GSHS cell phone policy: teachers will put phones out of reach during class.

I will strive to ...

- Respond to parent communications in a timely manner.
- Create a classroom environment that is conducive to learning.
- Provide a variety of learning experiences in an effort to meet all students' needs.
- Model respect for students.
