

Assignment 2: Generating Solutions (15%)

Let's say we finally understand the root cause and source of a problem - the impulse then becomes to focus on the first / immediate solution rather than explore all potential solutions exhaustively. The purpose of this assignment is to gain experience in developing creative and innovative solutions to the problem you explored in your first assignment.

What you need to do

- Review your feedback from Assignment 1.
- Review the generating solutions PPT resource.
- Apply three (3) problem-solving techniques to develop creative and innovative solutions to the problem you addressed in your problem definition assignment 1

This activity is focused on generating creative and innovation solutions. Evaluation of the solutions should NOT be completed as part of this assignment; however, applying three (3) generating solution techniques to come up with plenty of creative ideas given your depth of understanding of the problem is required to achieve full marks.
