

ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION

Federal legislation (Asbestos Hazard Response Act - AHERA) requires each primary and secondary school in the nation to complete a stringent inspection for asbestos and to develop a plan of management for all asbestos-containing building materials. Included in the AHERA Act is the requirement to annually notify all workers and building occupants (or their guardians) of asbestos-related activities.

The Oconto Unified School District has a list of the location(s) and type(s) of known/identified asbestos-containing materials found in that school building and a description and timetable for their proper management. New building materials installed after AHERA still have the potential to contain asbestos and should be sampled prior to any disturbance to ensure worker safety.
